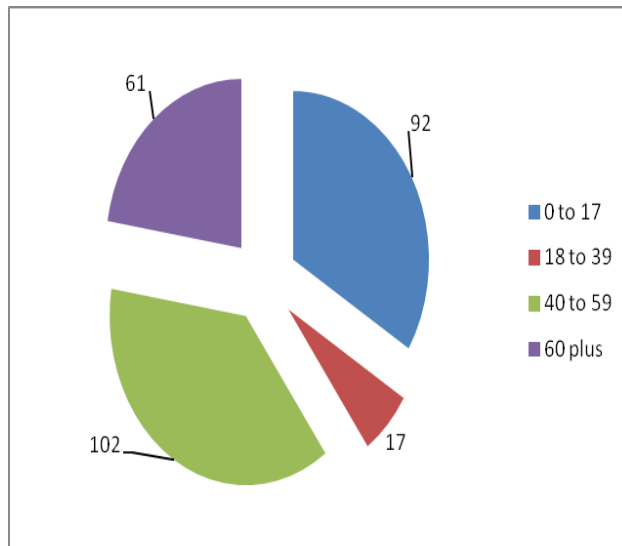
We had very few cancellations this year. We had numerous requests for overnight guests and managed to fill most of them. Some cancelled after being accepted as overnight guests.
