All Star I - 2020

Registrar's Report, Susan O'Loughlin

Registration for the 2020 All Star I Conference opened as planned on January 1, 2020, the same day the World Health Organization was sent to investigate a cluster of pneumonia cases in China. On-time registrations for All Star I closed on the usual March 10th registration deadline. The World Health Organization declared the COVID-19 pandemic on March 11th. On April 27th, all Star Island conferences were cancelled. This report summarizes registration activity up to April 27, 2020.

Registrations were slow during the 2020 registration period with a total of 294 registrations (compared to 354 in 2019 and 331 in 2018). (Note: 2 staff children were registered for the conference for the purpose of participating in the children's program but are not included in any of our registration numbers.) We had 13 people cancel (4 pre-acceptance; 9 post-acceptance)

In 2020, registered conferee ages ranged from 3 months to 91 years. The percent of children 17 and under was lower than past years. The percent of 18-39 year olds was slightly higher, and 40-59 year olds was consistent with prior years. The percent of conferees 60+ is stable (of note, 10 of the 13 cancellations were in this age group and COVID-19 was cited as the cause of the cancellation).
