This year's theme: Big Brain Island — Exploring the marvels and the mysteries of the mind from womb to tomb.

We hope to build on the success of last year's conference, incorporating the feedback we received from the evaluations about the various programs and activities that were popular, and continuing to strive toward an intellectually engaging, family-friendly, musically and artistically enriching conference.

Our speaker will be Dr. Caroline Hollnagel, a clinical neuropsychologist whose work explores the relationship between the central nervous system and behavior — a perfect fit for this year's theme. Her clinical and research interests include dementia, frontal lobe function in cognitive and behavioral inhibition, stroke and brain injury rehabilitation, first-break schizophrenia, and obsessive-compulsive disorder, with a focus on refining diagnosis and intervention for these conditions. She trained at Smith College and Washington University in St. Louis, completed a pre-doctoral internship at UCSF and a post-doctoral fellowship at the UCSF Memory and Aging Center, and has taught and mentored students, residents, and fellows at Washington University St. Louis, UC Berkeley, and UCSF throughout her career.
